



24th Agriculture and Livestock Exhibition Fair from 16th to 19th October 2019 at Badam Bagh Kabul - Afghanistan

The 24th Agriculture and Livestock Exhibition Fair was inaugurated in Kabul's Badam Bagh research farm on 16th October 2019 and continued for four days. In this AG-fair, a number of officials including the director of the agriculture development sector of MAIL, deputy minister for irrigation and natural resources at MAIL, and general directorate of Kuchis had participated.
