Artificial Insemination kits were distributed to five paravets

The Ministry of Agriculture, Irrigation and Livestock (MAIL) has always tried to find ways to solve the problems of Kuchis and Afghan ranchers for the growth of agriculture and livestock in all parts of Afghanistan. On Thursday 5th October 2019, MAIL with the cooperation of DCA under the CLAP Kuchi project had distributed AI (artificial insemination) kits for paravets who completed the 5-day refresher training. These kits include:

3. AI Gun
4. AI Gun sheet
5. Forceps
6. Steriliser
7. Liquid nitrogen meter
8. Semen straw
9. Tag machine
10. Tag number
11. Nitrogen for recharging
12. Rubber boot
13. AI gloves
14. Thermometer
15. Scissor (twizer)
16. Apron

18. Registration book
19. Microscope
20. Bag for kit
